PPC MEMBERS EXTENDING APPOLOGIES

The meeting was called to order at 2:09 pm on Aug 4 2022. The PPC decisions for each item on the agenda is recorded below:

1. PPC-UCCI-046-RFP Request by UCCI for Student Information System Consultant.

The PPC reviewed the submission and voted **to approve** the request.

A brief discussion was held by The PPC and Dr J.D Mosley Matchett, concerning the successful bidder, the two year contract, and the pricing breakdown.

Dr Mosley Matchett stated that she believed that the project was worth the value, and it would be of great benefit for incoming and exiting students.

2. PPC-2022-CIN-045-DA Request by CINICO for the renewal of Software Agreement

The PPC reviewed the submission and voted **to approve** the request.

A brief discussion was held by The PPC, Kahill Strachan and Michael Gayle, concerning alternatives to the current provider, the extension, and pending renewal of the contract,

The PPC stated that the procurement method was flawed, and that they should engage in a more competitive process in the future.

PPC Member Laura Panades- Estruch voted against this submission.

3. MEYSAL-EPC-q021-004 Review of Scanning Document Service for Lands/Survey.

The PPC reviewed the submission and voted **to approve** the request.

This project was deferred previously by the PPC on July 7th 2022.

A brief discussion was held between The PPC, Sophia Williams and Uche Obi, concerning the preferred bidder, and the cost of doing the project in house.

The PPC recommended that the Panel engage in discussions with the vendor to negotiate a better contract price.

4. PPC-2022-MOE-026-RFP / PPC-2022-MOE-027-RFP Request by Ministry of Education for Design Consult and Business Consult- LSHS.

The PPC reviewed the submission and voted **to approve** the request.

A brief discussion was held between The PPC and Wayne Riley concerning Cabinet's approval of the project, the preferred bidder, and the cost.

Mr. Riley stated that the preferred bidder had worked for other Government entities in the past, and that he believed this project was good value for money.

PPC Chairman Mr. Arek Joseph excused himself from this submission.

PPC members Laura Panades Estruch, and Elke Rose, voted against this submission.

5. PPC-2022-NRA-007-RFP Request by NRA for EIA for the EW Arterial.

The PPC reviewed the submission and voted **to approve** the request.

A brief discussion was held between The PPC, Edward Howard, Mark Scotland, and Denis Thibeault, concerning the bidders, the cost, study to be carried out, and the terms of reference.

6. PPC-2022-MOH-023-RFP Request by MOH for Garbage Containers

The PPC reviewed the submission and voted **to approve** the request.

A brief discussion was held between The PPC and Michael Haworth concerning the need for Commercial and Residential Containers, and the reason for a split procurement.

Mr Haworth stated that the ministry decided to split this project into two different procurements, Commercial and Residential, due to there being two different supply chains, and also, it provided much more clarity to those wishing to submit bids.
