Minutes of The Public Procurement Committee held February 5 2026, 12.30 pm, in Conference Room # 3028, Government Administration Building, 133 Elgin Avenue, George Town, Grand Cayman.

PPC-2025-CIAA-065-RFP Request to Fill East Parking Lot ORIA.

The PPC reviewed this application and voted to **approve** this request on February 5 2026.

The Public Procurement Committee met with Mark Whiteside, Nicholas Johnson and Eimer Powery on February 5 2026, and had a discussion regarding the preferred vendor, the contract cost, and the elimination of bidders.

The CIAA Panel explained that the preferred vendor was an established entity with a very strong project team, and that they believed they would be receiving good value for money on this project. The Panel also stated that bidders were eliminated due to lack of prior experience in handling projects of this nature.

The Public Procurement Committee instructed the Panel to submit a breakdown of the contract cost instead of a lump sum, to ensure that Procurement Principles of Transparency and Accountability were met.

PPC-2025-CIAA-081-RFP – Request for HVAC, Plumbing & Fire Protection at ORIA & CKIA.

The PPC reviewed this application and voted to **approve** this request on February 5 2026.

The Public Procurement Committee met with Mark Whiteside, Nicholas Johnson and Eimer Powery on February 5 2026, and discussed the background of the project, the contract cost and period, and the BAFO.

The CIAA Panel stated that they had an established professional relationship with the preferred vendor, the contract period would cover both airports for a 4-year period, and that a BAFO had been conducted, but the outcome was still pending.

PPC-2024-PACI-095-RFP – Request for IT Infrastructure Modernization.

The PPC reviewed this application and voted to **approve** this request on February 5 2026.

The Public Procurement Committee met with Chris Krohn on February 5 2026 and discussed the Proposed Management Platform, the bidders, the scope of works, the contract cost, and the budget.

Mr Krohn stated that bidders that did not meet the requirements were eliminated, funding was available to complete the purchase, the preferred vendor was local, and the contract also included training.

PPC-2025-CSD-091-RFP – Request for Firewall for Remote Data Centre.

This application was withdrawn by CSD and will be resubmitted at a later date.

PPC-2025-HSA-070-RFP – Request for the Expansion of Pasadora Dental.

The PPC reviewed this application and voted **not to approve** this request on February 5 2026.

The Public Procurement Committee met with Nadia Richards, Ricardo Prince, Christopher McNamee and Shogan Govender on February 5 2026, to discuss the contract cost, the preferred vendor, the scope of works, the lease agreement, and payment terms.

The Public Procurement Committee did not recommend the application because it failed to meet the required criteria in accordance with Procurement Principle # 9 Informed Decision Making, the project did not comply with standard procurement processes.

The Public Procurement Committee recommended that the HSA Panel contact the Central Procurement Office to obtain assistance in rectifying the application so that they could resubmit it at a later date.

PPC-2025-PWD-074-RFP – Request for Construction of Phase 2 George Dixon Park.

The PPC reviewed this application and voted to **approve** this request on February 5 2026.


