The meeting was called to order at 2:15 Pm on November 3 2022. The PPC decisions for each item on the agenda is recorded below:

1. PPC-2022-FED-018-RFP Request by FED for the provision of Banking Services

The PPC reviewed the submission and voted to approve the request.

A brief discussion was held between The PPC, Gloria Myles and Randy Myles, concerning the elimination of bidders, the budget, the allocation of cost (framework), the current supplier, and the duration of the contract.

2. PPC-2022-IISD-064-DA Request by IISD for the renewal of Cyber Security Agreement.

The PPC reviewed the submission and voted to approve the request.

A brief discussion was held between The PPC, Pamela Greene, Charles Brown, Vinton Chinsee and Aneal Sobie, concerning the bidders, the previous contract, the Framework Agreement, and the number of devices being covered.

Ms. Greene stated that they were moving from 8000 devices to 11,000, the contract period was 3 years, the license had to be paid in advance, and that the commencement of the contract would be December 2022.

3. PPC-2022-PWD-020-RFQ Revamp of Courtyard at UCCI.

The PPC reviewed the submission and voted to approve the request.

This project was rejected previously on July 7 2022.

A brief discussion was held between The PPC, Cherry Ann Mungroo, Keisha Calendar and Simon Ashdown, concerning the preferred vendor, project cost, the budget, and the need for a Bill of Quantities

Ms. Mungroo stated that the eliminated contractor was given a rectification period to resubmit, but his bid was quite excessive. She also promised a BOQ (outsourced) for future projects off this type.
